Executive Summary

Staff will provide information on the Cannabis Regulation and Tax Act to the Village President and Board of Trustees.

Discussion

Recently, the Illinois legislature passed the Cannabis Regulation and Tax Act, effectively legalizing the adult use of recreational cannabis in Illinois. The Governor signed the Act into law, and it will be effective on January 1, 2020. In addition to legalizing adult use cannabis, the Act also makes numerous other changes to Illinois law, with implications regarding taxation, zoning, licensing, labor and employment, and criminal records expungement. The passing of the Cannabis Regulation and Tax Act necessitates several decisions to be made at the Board level as to how the Village of Hanover Park will proceed with the new law.

In order to facilitate discussion, Staff will present an informational PowerPoint to provide an overview of the law and highlight decision points for the Village Board at a Workshop on September 5, 2019.
