8-a Open Discussion

- David Martinez - Husband of new Trustee – Veteran. Mayor would like him to become a permanent member of the Veterans Committee.
- Mayor Craig brought literature on the Flags for Roselle. A subscription can be taken out for a 3' x 5' flag to be placed in the front yard for five holidays. Memorial Day, Flag Day, Independence Day, Patriots Day and Veterans Day. There is a required minimum donation of \$50 per year for 2019. They put up the flags in the early morning and remove them at dusk.
- Tom Fortney – With Boy Scouts
- Lance Hall – Scout Master. Would like to do something very similar as the Flags for Roselle but through the Boy Scouts in the area. There is a troop in Batavia that has done this for the past 4 years. There are 40 scouts with 35 families that provide the same type of service. This program has been very successful since they place approximately 800 flags throughout the town. They will insert a sleeve in the ground and mark the curb where the sleeve is so pole can be placed in it year after year. Looking to begin local program in 2020. Subscription would run between \$25 - \$40. Want to start slow and focus on single family homes. Committee would like to see in high visibility

areas of Hanover Park and it would be called Flags Over Hanover Park.

Would hope to find sponsors for these flags.

- Mayor Craig would like to form a committee to review the merits of each program and decide which they would like to go with. The Committee would consist of Mayor Craig, T. J. Moore, Lions Club member, Veterans Committee member, Trustee Roberts and Lance Hall.
- Relay for Life on June 7<sup>th</sup> at 6:00 pm at Lake Park East High School.
- Gaming at the Post on May 10<sup>th</sup>.
